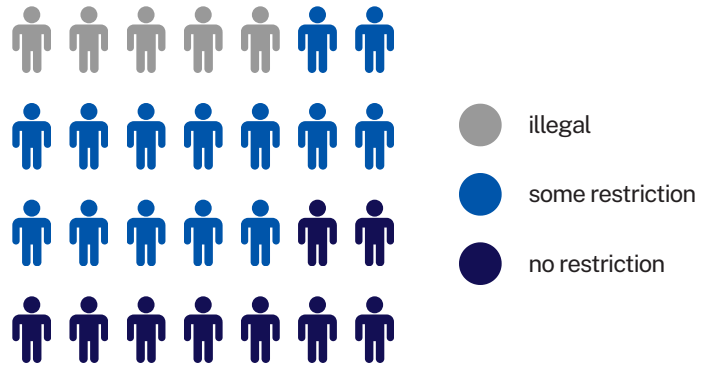


## A majority of Mississippians oppose the Supreme Court decision in *Dobbs v. JWHO* to overturn *Roe v. Wade*.

Only 18% of Mississippians think abortion should be illegal in all cases. 81% of Mississippians think abortion should be legal in some form—and 32% think abortion should be legal in all cases.

The majority of Mississippians believe women should have the choice to have an abortion up to 16 weeks into pregnancy.

84% of Mississippians believe individuals have the general right to privacy in making decisions related to their bodies.\*



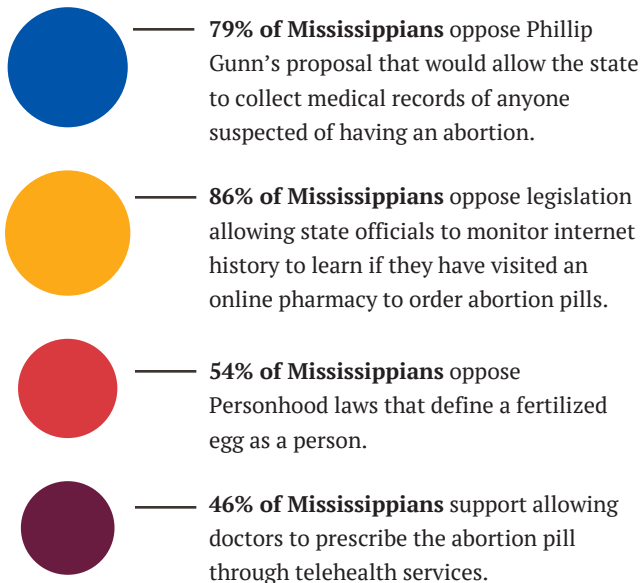
### Contraception

71% of Mississippians do not view emergency contraception such as IUDs and Plan B as methods of abortion.

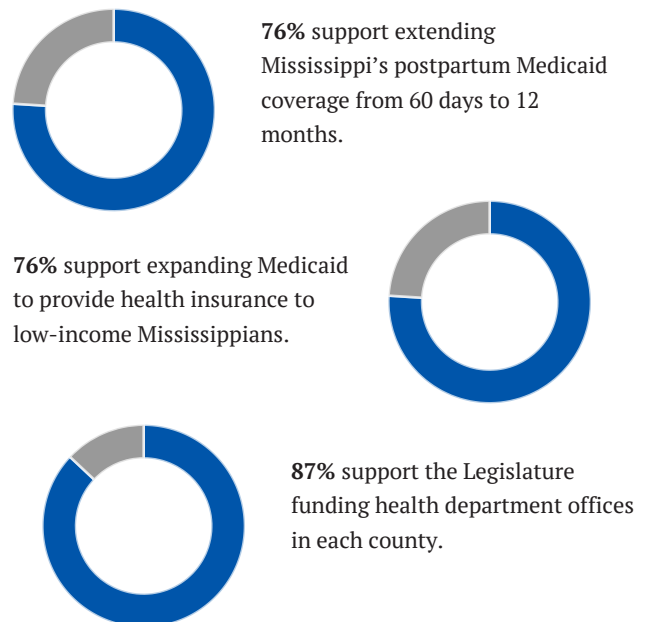
### Criminalization
